SIMPLE RESOLUTION OF COMPLEX
CESAREAN SECTION: THEORETICAL
AND PRACTICAL COURSE

Masterclass by Prof Nieto-Calvache and Prof Palacios Jaraquemada Organization Prof Martinez de Tejada, Dr De Oliveira, Dr Pellegrinelli

The incidence of pregnancies on a scarred uterus has increased in the last decades. The management of a suspected placenta accreta and of complex cesarean sections, has gained growing attention in recent years and has evolved considerably.

To share their expertise, the Obstetrics Division of the University Hospitals of Geneva invites you to a Masterclass led by two renowned, international specialists, Professor Nieto-Calvache and Professor Palacios Jaraquemada. Their groundbreaking work has greatly changed placenta accreta management, introducing a practical clinical approach that significantly reduces puerperal hysterectomy rates and morbidity.

The proposed surgical approach and techniques, helps also when performing complicated C-sections.

On Tuesday, June 24th, the morning session will cover theoretical backgrounds, followed by hands-on simulation workshops in the afternoon. The day will conclude with an interactive discussion on common and complex clinical cases, allowing participants to share their experiences.

On Wednesday, June 25th (half-day), participants will have the option to register (separately) for a dissection session on fresh cadavers, providing a unique opportunity to practice the techniques presented the day before.

The two proposed courses are designed for experienced obstetricians-gynecologists. Residents with at least 4 years of training can also attend the courses. The courses will be conducted in English and will be highly interactive, featuring extensive simulation opportunities.



Describe the areas and vascular pedicles of the female genital system.

Represent the pelvic spaces and their safe surgical access.

Describe and perform hemostasis of the lower uterine segment.

Repair the dehiscent uterine segment. Describe and perform internal aortic compression.

Describe the ultrasound signs of placenta accreta and other conditions of a complex cesarean section (uterine dehiscence, placenta previa, etc.).

Describe and simulate therapeutic options for placenta accreta.

Describe and simulate a hemostatic procedure for different uterine segments.

Plan and perform a complex cesarean section.
